The Prez Sez



The Sting!

This is not related to carving. Lately I have handled a lot of new \$20 and \$50 bills. The big problem with these bills ... they stick together. Is it good news to find an extra bill in your change or bad news to find yourself short a bill? For me when product count doesn't match cash received its definitely bad news.

Anyway, to minimize sticking I have a few tricks. First I fold the bill lengthwise then give the corner a finger snap. The folding should cause a vacuum break and the snap a separating force. The second trick is to wet a corner with a damp sponge and give the bill a snap. This should take care of any static electricity. Of course you can also use a spray bottle or metal plate. Better ask for old bills from the bank until their gone.

When counting old bills I stack them face up. To count the new bills I alternate them, one face up, the next face down. This makes the counting easier.

Another issue, the new credit cards. The new card readers now have a third option called "tap". Tap that machine and poof! .. the cash register spits out your receipt. No signature, no pin number, no ID check. Either wrap your wallet in aluminum foil or buy a credit card protector from London Drugs. Your wallet is radio active! 
